CATHEDRAL NEWS

Missions Collection — A second collection will be taken at all masses today, for distribution in missionary countries.

Road Closure — The road outside the Cathedral will be closed next Sunday, 29 October, between 5:30pm and 7:30pm to facilitate the Macnas parade.

Celebrations This Week — Feast of **Ss Simon & Jude**, apostles (28 October); optional memorials of **St John of Capistrano**, priest (23 October), **St Anthony Mary Claret**, bishop (24 October), **Bl. Thaddeus MacCarthy**, bishop (25 October; a feast in the Diocese of Cork & Ross and in the Diocese of Cloyne), and **St Otterman**, monk (27 October). St John Paul II, pope (22 October), is not celebrated this year as the Sunday takes precedence.
