CATHEDRAL NEWS

The Final October Rosary Procession takes place in the Cathedral at 8:00pm.

November Lists of the Dead are now available at the Cathedral doors – please return them for inclusion in the altar list before 2 November.

Last Sunday's Offertory Collection raised a total of €2,150.40: thank you for your continued support.

Celebrations This Week — Memorials of **St Malachy**, bishop (3 November; a feast in the Archdiocese of Armagh and the Diocese of Down & Connor), and **St Charles Borromeo**, bishop (4 November); optional memorial of **Bl. Dominic Collins**, martyr (31 October). St Colman, bishop (29 October), is not celebrated this year as the Sunday takes precedence, except in the Diocese of Kilmacduagh where he is celebrated as a solemnity.

COMMEMORATION OF THE FAITHFUL DEPARTED

All Souls' Day falls on Thursday 2 November; mass is at 11:00am and 6:00pm.

Plenary Indulgences for the souls of the departed in Purgatory

- From 12.00 noon on 1 November until 12.00 midnight on 2 November, all who have confessed within the week preceding or following 1 November, received Holy Communion on any day between 1 and 8 November and prayed for the Pope's intentions may gain **one plenary indulgence** by visiting a church or oratory and there reciting one Our Father and the Apostle's Creed.
- Those who visit a cemetery (including the Cathedral crypt) and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence **once per day** between 1 and 8 November. The same conditions apply.

The Crypt of the Cathedral will be open between 2 and 10 November.

Thursday 2 November	Victims of tragedies & accidents
Friday 3 November	Deceased by suicide
Saturday 4 November	Deceased babies, children & young people
Sunday 5 November	Deceased parents & family members
Monday 6 November	Deceased of the past year
Tuesday 7 November	Deceased migrants & all who have died abroad
Wednesday 8 November	Victims of war, violence & natural disasters
Thursday 9 November	Deceased of residential institutions
Friday 10 November	Deceased clergy & religious
