Celebrations This Week — Solemnities of Mary, the Holy Mother of God (1 January), and the Epiphany of the Lord (6 January); memorial of Ss Basil the Great & Gregory Nazianzen, bishops & doctors of the Church (2 January); optional memorials of the Holy Name of Jesus (3 January), St Munchin (Mainchin), bishop (3 January), and St Charles of St Andrew, priest (5 January). St Sylvester I, pope (31 December), is not celebrated this year.
