CATHEDRAL NEWS

Solemn Novena 2024 begins on Monday 5 February, and continues until Tuesday 13 February, with sessions daily at 11:00am, 1:10pm and 7:30pm (Sunday 10:30am, 12:30pm, 3:00pm and 6:00pm). Full details of this year's novena are on the Cathedral website: https://www.galwaycathedral.ie/novena.

Youth 2000 Gatherings take place on Wednesdays at 7:00pm: all aged between 18 and 35 years are welcome.

Celebrations This Week — Feast of the **Conversion of St Paul**, apostle (25 January); memorials of St Francis de Sales, bishop & doctor of the Church (24 January), and Ss Timothy & Titus, bishops (26 January); optional memorials of St Vincent, deacon & martyr (22 January), and St Angela Merici, virgin & religious (27 January). St Agnes, virgin & martyr (21 January), is not celebrated this year as the Sunday takes precedence.
