**Stations of the Cross** are prayed each Friday during Lent, immediately after the 6:00pm mass – all are welcome to take part.

**Last Sunday's Offertory Collection** amounted to €2,321.77: we are very grateful to all who continue to support the Cathedral.

**Vox Orbis**, an all-female choir directed by Mark Keane, gives a concert in the Cathedral on Wednesday 13 March at 8:00pm, together with Anne-Marie O'Farrell on harp. Admission is €15 at the door.

**Emigrants Collection** — There is a second collection at all Sunday masses next weekend, the proceeds of which go to the Council for Emigrants to provide outreach services in the UK, Europe, the USA and Canada.
