CATHEDRAL NEWS

Mass is Celebrated at 11:00am only between Monday 1 and Friday 5 April; the normal mass schedule resumes on Saturday 6 April.

The Cathedral Bookshop is open on Easter Monday, and for the rest of the week.

Divine Mercy Sunday will be celebrated in the Cathedral next Sunday, 7 April, at 2:00pm.

Eucharistic Adoration does not take place this week; it resumes on Sunday 7 April.

The Monday 8:00pm Holy Hour does not take place tomorrow, 1 April.

Lourdes Mass next Thursday, 4 April, at 8:00pm.

First Friday & Saturday — Next Friday and Saturday are the first of the month; Communion will be brought to the sick and housebound on Friday, and on Saturday there is Mass and office of Our Lady at 11:00am.
