Visiting Choirs — On Tuesday next we welcome the Kingwood Chorale (USA) to sing at the 11:00am mass, and the Elizabethtown College Choir (USA) to sing at the 6:00pm mass.

Rosary for the Month of May takes place each evening at 7:00pm in Elm Park Road (Greenfields), and all are welcome.

Last Sunday's Offertory Collection amounted to €2,390.39: we are very grateful for your continued support.

Celebrations this Week — Memorial of the **Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church** (20 May); optional memorials of **Ss Christopher Magallanes**, priest, and companions, martyrs (21 May), **St Rita of Cascia**, religious (22 May), **St Bede the Venerable**, priest & doctor of the Church (25 May), **St Gregory VII**, pope (25 May), and **St Mary Magdalene de' Pazzi**, virgin (25 May). St Bernadine of Siena, priest (20 May), is not celebrated this year as the memorial takes precedence.

Diocesan Pilgrimage to Lourdes takes place between 26 June and 1 July, and is led by Fr Martin Moran. The total cost is €899 including transport to and from Shannon Airport; special accommodation in the Accueil Notre Dame for those with particular needs is available for €825. Insurance (optional) in either case costs an extra €39.
