Celebrations this Week — Memorials of St Barnabas, apostle (11 June), and St Anthony of Padua, priest & doctor of the Church (13 June); optional memorials of Ephrem, deacon & doctor of the Church (10 June), and St Davnet, virgin (14 June). St Columba (Colum Cille), abbot & missionary and secondary patron of Ireland (9 June), is not celebrated this year as the Sunday takes precedence; however, in the Diocese of Derry and the Diocese of Raphoe he is celebrated as a feast on 10 June.

Insurance (optional) in either case costs an extra €39.
