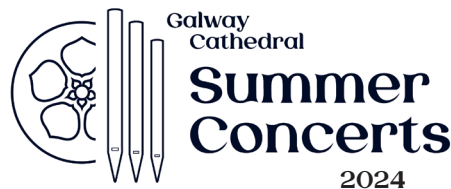

Peter's Pence Collection — The annual Peter's Pence collection, which goes to Rome in support of the pope's charities, will be taken at all masses today.

Celebrations this Week — Feast of St Thomas, apostle (3 July); memorial of St Oliver Plunkett, bishop & martyr (1 July; celebrated as a feast in the Archdiocese of Armagh and the Diocese of Meath); optional memorials of St Elizabeth of Portugal (4 July), St Anthony Zaccaria, priest (5 July), St Maria Goretti, virgin & martyr (6 July), and St Moninne, virgin (6 July).
