## CATHEDRAL NEWS

**Croí Concert** — The London Welsh Male Voice Choir give a concert in the Cathedral on Saturday 16 November at 7:30pm, with all proceeds in aid of Croí. **First Friday & Saturday** — Next Friday and Saturday are the first of the month; Communion will be brought to the sick and housebound on Friday, and on Saturday there is Mass and office of Our Lady at 11:00am.

**Celebrations this Week** — Feast of Ss Simon & Jude, apostles (28 October); optional memorial of St Colman, bishop (29 October; a feast in the Diocese of Kilmacduagh). Bl. Dominic Collins, martyr, is celebrated as a feast in the Diocese of Cloyne on 31 October. St Otteran, monk (27 October), is not celebrated this year as the Sunday celebration takes precedence, except in the Diocese of Waterford where it is a solemnity.

### COMMEMORATION OF THE FAITHFUL DEPARTED

All Souls' Day falls on Saturday 2 November; mass is at 11:00am and 6:00pm.

#### *Plenary Indulgences for the souls of the departed in Purgatory*

- From 12.00 noon on 1 November until 12.00 midnight on 2 November, all who have confessed within the week preceding or following 1 November, received Holy Communion on any day between 1 and 8 November and prayed for the Pope's intentions may gain **one plenary indulgence** by visiting a church or oratory and there reciting one Our Father and the Apostle's Creed.
- Those who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence **once per day** between 1 and 8 November. The same conditions apply.
