CATHEDRAL NEWS

Service of Adoration for Vocations takes place in the Cathedral on Sunday 24 November, between 7:00pm and 9:00pm; the monstrance will be one of six blessed specially in November 2004 by Saint John Paul II to be used as a focus of prayer for vocations.

Remembrance Tree Mass — The 6:00pm mass on Thursday 5 December will be offered for all those whose names have been placed on the remembrance tree.
