RCIA Candidates — A short rite of acceptance and welcome of new candidates to the catechuminate takes place at the 12:30pm mass today.

Service of Adoration for Vocations takes place in the Cathedral this evening between 7:00pm and 9:00pm; the monstrance will be one of six blessed specially in November 2004 by Saint John Paul II to be used as a focus of prayer for vocations.

Remembrance Tree Mass — The 6:00pm mass on Thursday 5 December will be offered for all those whose names have been placed on the remembrance tree.

The Offertory Collection last Sunday came to €2,523.80; sincere thanks for your continued support.

Diocesan Family Services Collection — There is a second collection at all masses today, in aid of family services run by the diocese; these include Accord and the Western Regional Marriage Tribunal.

Celebrations this Week — Feast of St Andrew, apostle (30 November); optional memorials of St Catherine of Alexandria, virgin & martyr (25 November), St Clement I, pope & martyr (25 November), St Colman, bishop (25 November; in the Diocese of Cloyne, transferred from 24 November and celebrated as a feast), and St Fergal, bishop & missionary (27 November). St Andrew Dũng-Lạc, priest, and companions, martyrs, are not celebrated this year as the Sunday celebration takes precedence.
