Solemn Novena 2025 takes place between Monday 17 and Tuesday 25 February.

Celebrations this Week — Feast of the Conversion of St Paul, Apostle (25 January); memorials of St Agnes, virgin & martyr (21 January), and St Francis de Sales, bishop & doctor of the Church (24 January); optional memorials of St Fabian, pope & martyr (20 January), St Sebastian, martyr (20 January), and St Vincent, deacon & martyr (22 January).

Charitable Donation Scheme — If you are an Irish taxpayer and have contributed more than €250 to the Cathedral within a calendar year, you can enhance the value of your donation — at no additional cost to yourself — by filling a CHY4 form (available from the Cathedral office or from the Revenue website) and returning it to the office. This allows us to avail of Revenue's Charitable Donation Scheme and reclaim a portion of the tax paid on the donation. Please contact the office for more details.
