Prayer Service, 7:00pm – 9:00pm, with exposition, confession, reflection, music and ashes.

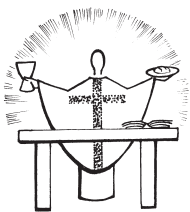
OTHER NEWS
