Rosary for the Month of May takes place each evening at 7:00pm, at the grotto in Elm Park Road, Greenfields. The rosary concludes next Saturday, 31 May, with mass at the grotto at 7:30pm; chairs will be provided.

Agri Aware Open Farm Day offers the public an opportunity to experience the inner workings of a modern Irish farm. It takes place this year on Sunday 15 June, on the Fahy family farm, Ardrahan, Co. Galway (H91 TPD2), and includes interactive demonstrations such as sheep shearing, milking and cookery displays, and much more.
