Corpus Christi Procession — Next Sunday, 22 June, is the feast of Corpus Christi. The annual procession takes place that afternoon, starting with mass in the Franciscan Abbey at 3:00pm and then proceeding to the Poor Clare Monastery, Nuns' Island.
