## **CATHEDRAL NEWS**

**Relics of Blessed Matt Talbot** visit the Cathedral on Friday 25 July, with mass at 6:00pm, a talk at 7:00pm on the life and witness of Matt Talbot, rosary at 7:30pm, and a guided eucharistic holy hour at 9:00pm with prayers for healing and strength.

**Visiting Choir** — We welcome the combined choirs of St James' Church and St Albert's Church, from Louisville, Kentucky (USA), to the 10:30am mass today.

The Offertory Collection last Sunday amounted to €3,022.87 – sincere thanks to all who continue to support the Cathedral in this way.

**National Outreach Services Collection** — There is a second collection at all Sunday masse snext weekend in support of the various commissions established by the Irish Bishops' Conference. These commissions offer leadership, formation, pastoral care and ministry to the people of God.

**Celebrations this Week** — Feasts of St Mary Magdalene (22 July), St Bridget of Sweden, religious, patron of Europe (23 July), and St James, apostle (25 July); optional memorials of St Lawrence of Brindisi, priest & doctor of the Church (21 July), St Sharbel Makhlūf, priest (24 July), and St Declan, bishop (24 July; a feast in the Diocese of Waterford & Lismore). St Appoline, bishop & martyr (20 July), is not celebrated this year as the Sunday celebration takes precedence.
