CATHEDRAL NEWS

The Cathedral Choir returns today from its summer break.

Heat & Light Collection — A second collection will be taken at all Sunday masses next weekend, in aid of the upkeep of the Cathedral.

The Offertory Collection last Sunday amounted to €2,873.99 – sincere thanks to all who continue to support the Cathedral in this way.

Diocesan Youth Faith Collection — A total of €1,165.77 was contributed to last weekend's collection, for which we are very grateful.

St Patrick's Brass Band holds its annual church gate collection today.

Celebrations this Week — Feast of the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary (8 September); memorials of St Ciaran, abbot (9 September; a feast in the Diocese of Clonmacnois), and St John Chrysostom, bishop & doctor of the Church (13 September); optional memorials of St Peter Claver, priest (10 September), the Most Holy Name of Mary (12 September), and St Ailbe, bishop (12 September; a feast in the Diocese of Cashel & Emly).

Galway Camino

A Jubilee of Hope pilgrim walk to seven holy places in Galway City, taking place on Saturday 13 September 2025:

- · Galway Cathedral
- The Franciscan Abbey, St Francis Street
- St Nicholas' Collegiate Church
- The Augustinian Church, St Augustine Street
- St Mary's Dominican Church, Claddagh
- The Joseph's Church, Presentation Road
- The Poor Clare Monastery, Nuns' Island

The walk is self-directed, and begins at the Cathedral at any time from 12:00 noon onwards, where they receive a booklet to be stamped at each destination. At the end of the walk they return to the Cathedral (before 5:30pm) to receive a certificate of completion. The cost is €5.00 per person, €4.00 concession (unemployed/OAP/etc.), or €10.00 per family.
