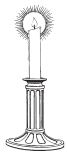
November Lists of the Dead are available at all the doors – please return your list before 2 November.

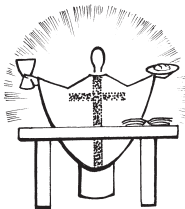
