**Live Crib** — The annual live crib takes place in the Cathedral grounds on Tuesday 16 December, between 11:30am and 4:00pm.

**Carol Service** —The Cathedal carol service takes place on Thursday 18 December, at 7:30pm, with Bishop Duignan presiding.

The Offertory Collection last Sunday amounted to €2,725.61, and on the previous Sunday to €3,302.53 – sincere thanks to all who continue to support the Cathedral in this way.
