Ecumenical Prayer Service — The annual Week of Prayer for Christian Unity takes place this year between 18 and 25 January. An ecumenical prayer service will be held in the Chapel of St Columbanus, University of Galway, on Sunday 25 January at 7:00pm, with Bishop Michael Duignan and Bishop Michael Burrows in attendance, and all are welcome.
