CATHEDRAL NEWS

Ecumenical Prayer Service takes place in the Chapel of St Columbanus, University of Galway, at 7:00pm this evening, with Bishop Michael Duignan and Bishop Michael Burrows in attendance, and all are welcome.

Youth 2000 Gathering on Wednesday next, 28 January, at 7:00pm.

Bereavement Support, provided by the Cathedral Bethany Group, is available in the Cathedral on Thursday next, 29 January, between 7:00pm and 8:00pm.

9:00am Mass As Gaeilge will not be celebrated on Sunday 8 February.

World Day of Consecrated Life will be marked in the Cathedral at the 12:30pm mass next Sunday, 1 February, when we welcome the religious congregations of the diocese.

Solemn Novena 2026 — The 2026 Solemn Novena takes place between Monday 2 and Tuesday 10 February: full details are on the Cathedral website, and on the brochures available at the doors.

Blessing of Throats — The Feast of Saint Blaise falls this year during the Solemn Novena. In order to preserve the prayerful focus of the Novena celebrations, blessing of throats will be offered only at the 6:00pm mass on Sunday next, 1 February.

The Offertory Collection last Sunday amounted to €2,893.07 — sincere thanks to all who continue to support the Cathedral in this way.

An Ghailíl Collection — There is a second collection at all masses today in aid of An Ghailíl Centre of Formation for Mission and Ministry, which offers training and formation for lay ministers, youth faith programmes and parish initiatives.

Celebrations This Week — Memorials of Ss Timothy & Titus, bishops (26 January), St Thomas Aquinas, priest & doctor of the Church (28 January), and St John Bosco, priest (31 Saturday); optional memorials of St Angela Merici, virgin & religious (27 January), and St Aidan, bishop (30 January; a feast in the Diocese of Ferns). In both the Archdiocese of Dublin and the Diocese of Meath, Bl. Margaret Bell and Francis Taylor, martyrs, may be celebrated as an optional memorial on 30 January. The conversion of St Paul, apostle (25 January), is not celebrated this year as the Sunday takes precedence.
